Dear Parents and Guardians,

We know that you, like us, are mourning the tragedy in Florida. I hope that you have read the messages sent from CFISD that explain security procedures. We would like to share with you what we have shared with our student body.

Our policy is that ID badges be worn by students and staff when on school grounds or at a school activity. We stress daily that the badges are necessary for identification and reunification. Badges serve as a way of determining who belongs on campus.

We insist that doors not be propped open and that students and staff not open doors for others. Staff members are to use their badges for entrance. Students are to report to the front rotunda for entry any time after 7:20 a.m.


Students are not to leave campus without properly checking out. Students who drive must have prior parent permission that has been verified. Parents are requested to follow the procedure of coming to the attendance office to check a student out from school. We insist that students be picked up in the front of the building rather than friends or parents coming to the back parking lots.

Any materials brought to school for a student must be delivered by a guardian, to the rotunda. Meeting a student in the parking lot is not acceptable. To make payments we encourage parents to set up a Cash Net account.

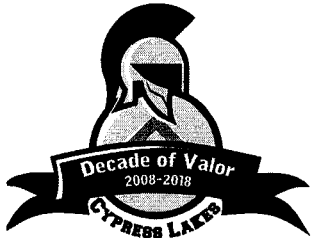
Finally, we ask students to "If you see it, say it." Our students and staff are our best source of information. They should immediately report out of the ordinary behavior to an adult.
