

Safety, Security and Dress Code Updates for the 2018-2019 School Year

In an effort to improve on current safety measures, the following changes will be implemented for the 2018-2019 school year:

- Except for school sponsored activities, **students will not be allowed in the building until 6:45 AM** each morning.
- There will be **designated entry points** for student entry in the morning: the main front doors, the auditorium entrance, the Fine Arts Hallway, the back of the Commons, and the Athletic hallway.
 - Once school starts at 7:20 AM, all students must enter through the main front doors.
- **All students must wear an ID badge, on a lanyard**, at all times during regular school hours.
- Only **clear bags** will be allowed inside the building. For more information about the clear bag policy, please visit www.cfid.net

To ensure that students have a successful transition to Cypress Lakes High School, we ask that students follow these dress code guidelines:

- Shorts and skirts must be at least mid-thigh.
- Shirts must have sleeves and cover the shoulder. Midriffs must be covered.
- Leggings or tights must be accompanied by shirts/dresses that are at least mid-thigh.
- Hats, visors, hoodies, or items that cover the head are not allowed.
- Clothing should not reveal undergarments.
- Jeans/pants should not have cuts/tears above the knees that reveal skin.
- Clothing should not promote or advertise items that are prohibited at school—alcohol, drugs, weapons, or inappropriate language.
